 - An award of \$1000.
- PhD students must be pursuing studies in Aquatic Resources at Texas State University.
- Undergraduate and masters students must be pursuing studies in Aquatic Biology at Texas State University.
- Students must be full-time.
- Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Awards are based on ability and achievement rather than on financial need.
