

**Criteria for Nominating The College of Science**  
**Outstanding Graduate Student Award**

**Deadline: January 24, 2005**

The **Outstanding Graduate Student** for the College of Science shall be determined on the basis of work done while in Graduate College at Texas State University-San Marcos. (This is meant to set limits for the time, but not the location of the work.) December candidates are eligible.

In determining the recipient, scholarship, research, teaching, and service shall be considered. In each of these categories, evidence to be weighed may include (but not be limited to):

***Scholarship***

G.P.A., GRE scores, expository seminars and presentations

***Research***

Thesis, grants, presentations, articles, laboratory or professional activities

***Teaching***

Teaching, excellence in lecturing, lab instruction or group instruction

***Service***

Club leadership, advising, hosting conferences
