- An essay outlining what type of community involvement the student had during the prior twelve (12) months. The non-profit’s name must be clearly listed as well as volunteer job duties. Please give specific examples and discuss the time involved in each activity.
- A **current resume** listing dates of employment, number of hours worked and position(s) held, as well as leadership positions and academic achievements for the past year.
- One new **letter of recommendation** (not recommendation forms) mailed directly to the applicant, preferably from Texas State faculty or staff, attesting to a commitment to Texas State’s core values, the student’s community service work over the academic year, and his/her leadership abilities.

The applicant should mail the entire application packet, including application form, resume, essay, and letter of recommendation to:
