Continuing Graduate Mitte Scholar Information

A “CONTINUING GRADUATE MITTE SCHOLAR” is a student who received a Mitte Graduate Scholarship the previous year.

General Info

Scholarships issued:

- In the amount of \$5,000 per year; \$2,500 for each fall and spring semester.
- For 2-3 years.
- Renewed annually at the discretion of the Foundation.
- Not issued during summer.

Qualifications

The applicant must:

- Achieve 3.5 cumulative GPA by the end of the academic year.
- Enroll in at least 6 hours of graduate study each fall and spring.
- Volunteer time towards meaningful community service, as defined by the Mitte Foundation
- Participate in events that are scheduled specifically for recipients of Mitte Scholarships.
- Participate in the student-based organization, the Mitte Society.
- Demonstrate a commitment to TSU’s core values, including leadership outside the classroom, commitment to community, and honesty.
- Submit a renewal application each award year.

Renewal application process

Renewal application must be submitted to the Office of the Graduate College by **MARCH 1** and must contain:

- A Scholarship application from <http://www.gradcollege.txstate.edu/scholarships.html> (BUT ONLY FOR A SHORT TIME BEFORE THE DEADLINE!)
- A current resume
- A 200-word essay outlining the type of community involvement the applicant had during the prior 12 months.
- One new letter of recommendation, preferably from TSU faculty or staff, attesting to a commitment to TSU’s core values, the student’s community service work over the academic year, or his or her leadership abilities.
